

COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment Booking Information Sheet

March 11, 2021

Vaccination appointments will be done according to age. **Currently booking persons age 85 and older.** Additional specific categories will be added when Phase 2 gets underway. Appointments can be made in one of two ways.

Online: saskatchewan.ca/covid19-vaccine

Telephone: 1-833-Sask-Vax (1-833-727-5829)

Online:

To book online go to saskatchewan.ca/covid19-vaccine. This site is mobile friendly.

You will need a valid Saskatchewan health card and a cell number or email address in order to receive a reminder of the appointment 24 hours beforehand. Family members or support persons may book an appointment for an eligible person. The online booking site can be accessed from outside Saskatchewan. The booking site will display a list of clinic options, dates and available appointment times. There are clinic locations across the province. Once a clinic is full it will be removed from the site. Please be patient as more clinics will become available as more vaccine is received.

Telephone:

To book by phone call **1-833-Sask-Vax (1-833-727-5829)** Open 8 am to 11 pm 7 days a week.

Please use the telephone booking option if you do not have a current Saskatchewan Health card or do not have a cell phone or email account. (The exception is Lloydminster residents with an Alberta health card).

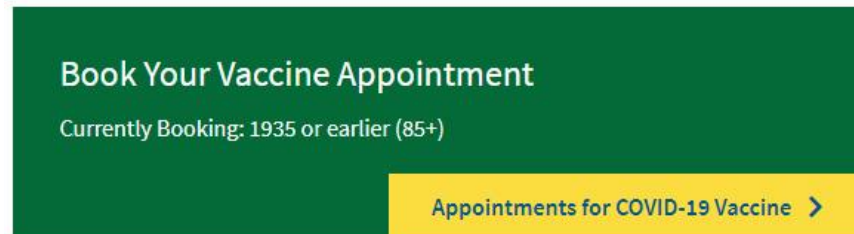
When the time comes to add the additional categories, telephone booking must also be used by:

- Health care workers
- Individuals considered clinically extremely vulnerable

Please do not use the phone booking if you are able to book online to conserve this option for those who need it. Please be patient and be prepared to wait if there are high call volumes.

How will I know when it's my turn (age group/additional categories) to get vaccinated?

Visit saskatchewan.ca/covid19-vaccine. The current eligible groups for vaccination will be prominently displayed next to the **online booking** button. As vaccines become more available the vaccinations may move swiftly through age groups so check back frequently to determine when you are eligible.

The current eligible categories for vaccination will also be included in the daily COVID news releases and through public service announcements.

Additional Information:

- Persons over 70 will not be receiving a phone call and now need to book online or by telephone when this age group become eligible.
- Once you are eligible you will not lose your place in line. You may book an appointment any time during the immunization program.
- Identification is required at the time of the appointment to confirm eligibility. Any attempt to provide false information in an attempt to 'jump the queue' may result in a criminal investigation.
- Visit saskatchewan.ca/COVID19-vaccine for more detailed information including vaccine safety fact sheets.
- These appointments will be for first doses.
- There will not be a choice of vaccine. It will be what the clinic location is offering.
- The telephone call centre will not have more access to appointments than what is available online.
- Additional vaccination location options such as pharmacies will be available in the coming weeks once allocations of vaccine have been received. Pharmacies will have their own process for booking appointments.
